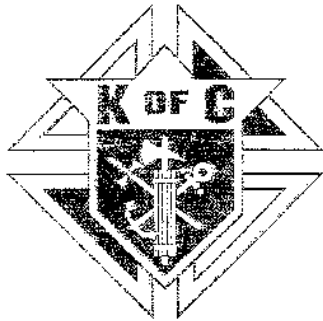

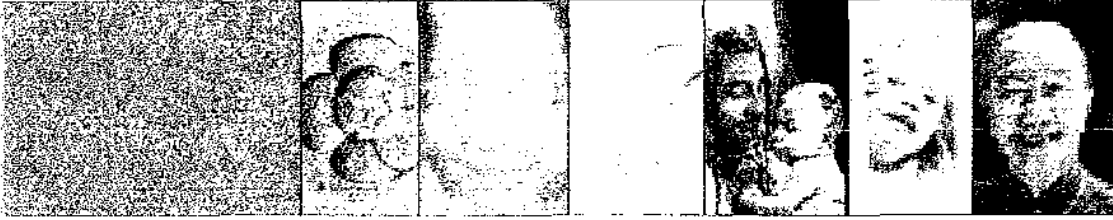
## FOURTH DEGREE KNIGHTS

Grand Knight Peter Baker presented certificates to five members of the council who were exemplified to the Fourth Degree of the Order in February. These men now carry the title "sir knight" and serve the order as members of the Bishop's Honor Guard at ceremonial occasions such as ordinations and confirmations. The Fourth Degree is a separate organization of knights and does not represent a "promotion" for a Knight of Columbus. Full knighthood is present in any person initiated into the Third Degree of the order. Fourth Degree knights wear a distinctive uniform with a cape and sword while there is no uniform for council—third degree—members.
